Uniform Marking System

Grades are based on the total work of the marking period including: classwork, projects, tests, homework, attendance, and punctuality. All grades must be numeric.

Numeric Grades : 55 – 99 in one digit increments.

Leveled Grades:

1. Far below the standard performance level
2. Approaching the standard performance level
3. At the standard performance level
4. Far above the standard performance level

Honor Rolls:

All subjects are included. They are weighted based upon the number of weekly periods of instruction.

All citizenship grades must be S or E including Homeroom.

Principal's List: 95 average no mark under 90.

High Honors: 90 average no mark under 85.

Honors: 85 average no mark under 80.

Merit: 80 average no mark under 75.

Arista Requirements:

All students must attain a 90% average or higher for the first three marking periods, a Level 3 or 4 on the ELA and Math state tests, and a satisfactory citizenship grade.
